

St. George Pilgrimage to St. Paisios Monastery

Friday, 12:00 pm, Feb. 1st – Sunday, 6:00pm, Feb. 3rd



Please join your fellow parishioners on a beautiful pilgrimage to begin the New Year at St. Paisios women's monastery in Safford, AZ. This is an English-speaking monastery under His Grace, Bishop MAXIM of the Serbian Western American Diocese and of the Abbess Michaila. Our group will leave Prescott at noon on Friday as the Monastery gate closes at 6:00pm and doesn't re-open until morning, and will return on Sunday after the Divine Liturgy and lunch, arriving back in Prescott around 6:00pm. Pilgrims will be required to attend an orientation meeting with Fr. Apostolos to learn the essential protocols of monastic life. This promises to be an energizing weekend of silent reflection and prayer, with catechism classes to be conducted by Fr. Dorotheos. This pilgrimage is open to adults 18 and over. Though the monastery does not charge her pilgrims, it is customary to make a donation. The monastery bookstore is filled with spiritual books and with the prayer ropes made by the sisters.
